

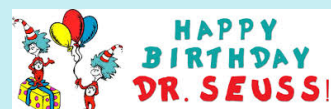

For more than thirty years, as a beloved fixture in American homes, Fred Rogers gave us what we needed. Warm and welcoming, he spoke directly to children and their parents about the tiny marvels of the world around them, the things that caused them worry, and the daily miracles that brought them joy, and above all, the importance of being themselves.



At Sunrise we will be developing a 2-part training for staff and families to explore and learn how Mr. Rogers can still change the world. Dates and times will be announced once the project is ready.
